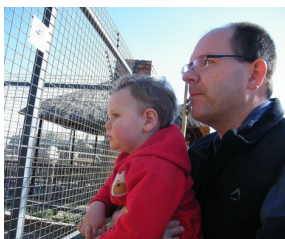

We praise the Lord that the foundations that she has laid in these ladies lives have put them in good stead for further learning.

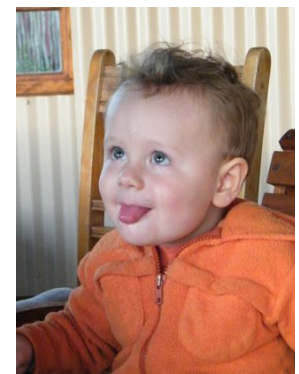

We will miss them!
